ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of 18 years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Colorado, as contained in Article 20 of the General Statutes of Colorado, entitled "Corporations Not for Profit", and the amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

1. Name. The name of the Corporation is The Athletic Association of Black Forest, Inc.
2. Duration. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
3. Purposes. The purposes for which this Corporation is to be formed are:
  - (a) To promote, foster, encourage and provide, on a nonprofit basis, any and all kinds of athletic events with particular emphasis upon such events where children may participate, and to promote, foster and encourage good sportsmanship in all such athletic events.
  - (b) To construct, operate, maintain and improve, and to buy, own, sell, convey, assign, mortgage or lease any real estate and any personal property necessary or incident to the purposes of this corporation.
  - (c) To purchase, hold, lease, or otherwise acquire and to sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of present and future interests in real, personal, mixed, tangible or intangible property of every kind and description whatsoever necessary or incidental to the furthering of the objects of this corporation.
  - (d) To do and engage in any and all such other acts, things, business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects and purposes hereinbefore enumerated; or calculated, directly or indirectly to promote the interest of the corporation in carrying out its purposes, or for the purpose of furthering any

of its ideals and purposes, to do any and all acts and things to exercise any and all other powers which a natural person could do or exercise and which are now or may hereafter be authorized by law.

4. Membership corporation. The Corporation will be of one class; designated as "General members", who shall pay such dues as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

5. Election of directors. Directors of the Corporation shall be elected in the manner provided by the Bylaws.

6. Address. The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is as follows:
